# Two Year Academic Advancement Course

# One Year and Six Month Academic Advancement Course

Both courses are for those who wish to enter Japanese universities, colleges, or graduate schools. The courses are focused on improving 4 skills of Japanese (reading, listening, speaking and writing) comprehensively and developing the habit of studying Japanese systematically. We organize preparatory classes for the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) and the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT), and also teach how to write an application essay or a short essay and how to prepare for the interview test. For those who wish to enter graduate school we teach how to write research plan and a dissertation. Aiming for successful admission to university or college we make careful learning plans and give the students useful advice about their life and study.

### **Features of JLC**

#### 1.Detailed teaching and guidance

We provide the students with the detailed guidance based on the questionnaires from the students, giving information on universities and colleges and advising the possibility to pass/fail the entrance exam. To achieve efficient learning effect, we use the following methods.

#### 2. Careful Student Support

The teachers and life counsellors give useful advice through orientation and counselling so that the students can become accustomed to a new life in Japan smoothly and concentrate on their study. Our staff members may meet new students at the airport when they arrive in Japan and provide assistance in alien registration, bank account opening, hospital companion, and part-time job searching. There are also some bilingual members available in our staff.

#### 3. Various Extraeurricular Activities

It is essential to understand Japanese culture for the study of Japanese language. You may have many opportunities to learn Japanese tradition, culture, and customs and to communicate with Japanese people through various extracurricular activities (school excursions and other school events).

## Accommodation

JLC arranges various types of accommodation where the students can live comfortably and concentrate on studying Japanese. There are many apartments and rental rooms near the school that students can rent at a reasonable price. If two persons rent a room together, for instance, the rent per person for a month will be approximately 25,000 – 30,000 JPY. We will send you information about accommodation before you come to Japan.

## **Brief Introduction to Nagoya**

NAGOYA where JLC Language Institute is located, is right in the middle of Japan and is one of the three biggest cities along with Tokyo and Osaka. In Nagoya the manufacturing industry is flourishing, and Toyota, the world's leading manufacturer of automobile, is headquartered near Nagoya. Many industrial products produced in Nagoya are not only supplied in Japan, but also exported overseas.







Because of the city's convenient position between Tokyo and Osaka and the excellent transportation network, like expressways and Shinkansen (bullet train), it is easy to go everywhere else in Japan from Nagoya. The Nagoya subway system covers almost the whole area of the city.



Both domestic and overseas travels have become even easier since the opening of the Central Japan International Airport (Centrair) in 2005. The southwestern area of Nagoya faces the sea, where there is Nagoya Port, the important port for international trade in Japan.Nagoya is rich in historic remains, like Nagoya Caste and Atsuta Shrine, and also has excellent cultural facilities (museums, art galleries and theatres.)

The city is convenient for living, as there are many shopping and dining places. Prices are lower in Nagoya than Tokyo and Osaka, and the climate Nagoya is relatively mild, making it an ideal place for international students to study Japanese.







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
